## Attendance \& Attainment

## Regular school attendance is important in order that your child reaches their full potential

The information below is taken from the DCSF National Strategy and demonstrates the possible impact of attendance upon attainment.


Attendance levels can sometimes be regarded in the same way as examination results. In an examination $80 \%$ would be a very positive result. In attendance terms that would mean that your child has missed 40 days of education, just over 1 day per week. Therefore if your child's attendance remains at $80 \%$ for the whole of their secondary education they will miss more than a full year of education.

## Attendance Rates

93.5\%+ = Very good chance of 5(9-4) Grades
$92.5 \%=$ Good chance of $5(9-4)$ Grades
$91.5 \%=$ Fair chance of 5 (9-4) Grades
$90 \%=$ Less than $50 \%$ chance of $5(9-4)$ Grades
$88 \%=$ Less than $35 \%$ chance of $5(9-4)$ Grades Less than $88 \%=$ Less than $30 \%$ chance of $5(9-4)$ Grades
In order for your child to achieve the highest possible grades they must be in school
