HOMEWORK

Homework is a very important part of school life and I appreciate all of the support we receive from parents in ensuring our students see homework as a priority. It is, quite rightly, one area that I am contacted about the most, by parents. The school has high expectations of homework and we use the 'Show My Homework' system to record and track engagement and completion of homework. Within Y7 and 8 homework is directly linked to our IMYC 'themes' and is presented as a menu via the IMYC booklet which students take home, as well as being uploaded onto 'Show my Homework' for electronic submission. In Y9-Y11, homework tasks are related to GCSE/BTEC courses of study and take many forms; including revision, assignments, extended learning and much more. All students and parents/carers have a dedicated log on to use the system which can be accessed via the school website as well as a free downloadable app. Moving forwards, we will be reporting on 'attitude towards homework' in order to share your son/daughter's engagement within this.
